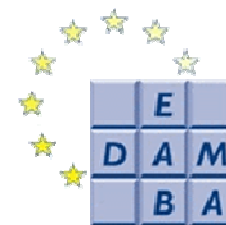
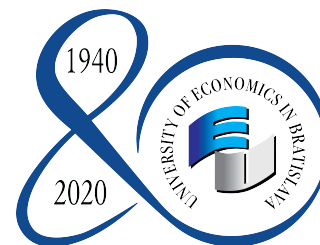

Some papers will be invited for open access publication in the *Economic Review* - Scientific Journal of the University of Economics in Bratislava (ISSN 0323-262X) indexed in Copernicus, EBSCO Host databases and listed in the ERIH PLUS.
- Subject to a signed licence agreement, all the accepted papers will be published online in the *Conference Proceedings* (with ISBN number) and sent for inclusion in the *Conference Proceedings* Citation Index by the Web of Science database:
